Stage 1: "Using the toilet is part of my day" (6 – 15m)

Où ça pousse ?

Put a potty in each toilet

Model using the toilet

Establish a routine for them to use it

Make it interesting to be there

They connect toilet with wee/poo

Stage 2: "I am gaining control over my body" (9 – 24m)



Multiple trips to potty each day

Starting to find their rhythm


Give them nappy-free time
